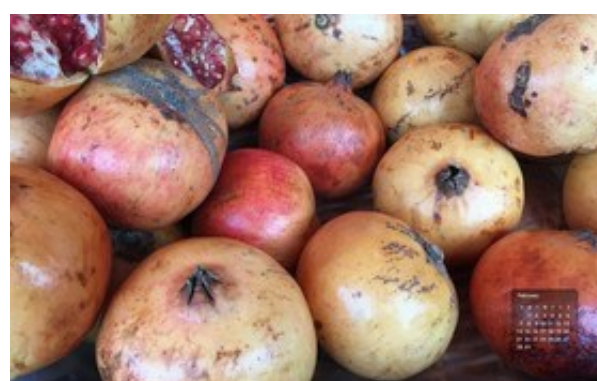


## February 2nd: Groundhog vs. Crêpes
