One of my friends believed you always had to buy more than one pair of shoes at a time and I always felt the same way about books.

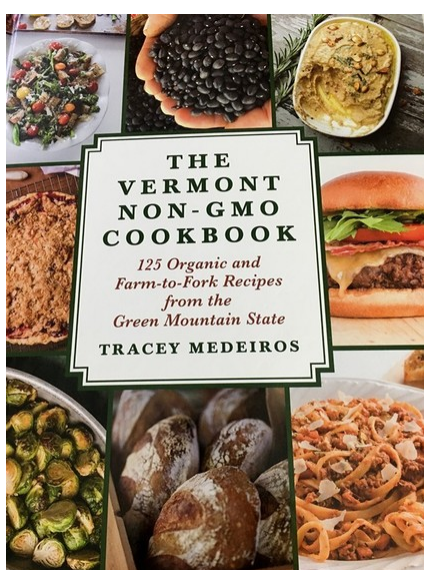
